

## General Description

You will **create** wireframes or final mockups specifically targeting mobile screen sizes, rethinking the layout so essential information fits without overwhelming the user. This includes potentially **collapsing** the nav bar into a hamburger menu and stacking sections vertically.

## What the Freelancer Needs / Requirements

1. **Access to the Original Desktop Designs**
  - Refer to UI/UX #2–#5 so you can adapt them to smaller breakpoints.
2. **Mobile UX**
  - Larger tap areas (44px min height), simplified layouts, fewer columns in grids, etc.
3. **Key Pages**
  - At least homepage, catalog, basket, and checkout for demonstration.

## Task Description

By completing these sub-tasks, you will **create** a mobile-friendly set of layouts that demonstrate how Bookify's top pages scale down to phone sizes. This is crucial for modern usage, as many users will rent books from their phones.

### Task 1

1. **Identify Which Pages to Convert**
  - Typically the homepage, catalog, basket, checkout.
  - If time permits, also do the account page.
2. **Mobile Wireframes**
  - Sketch each page at ~375px width.

### Task 2

1. **High-Fidelity Mobile Mockups**
  - Use brand styling, but compress or stack elements.
  - Show how the nav becomes a hamburger menu or bottom nav bar if needed.
2. **Focus on Tap Targets**
  - Ensure buttons, forms, and links are comfortably sized and spaced.

### Task 3

1. **Documentation**

- Label margins, recommended breakpoints (e.g., “This layout applies up to 600px”).
- Show or describe how each section collapses (one-column vs. multi-column).

## 2. **Sample Interactions**

- If using Figma or XD, optionally link or prototype how the user navigates mobile pages (tap hero CTA → catalog, etc.).
