Provide a single board or PDF with updated components states (default, hover, focus, disabled), ensuring the brand from UI/UX #1 is still consistent.

What the Freelancer Needs / Requirements

- **Design Tool**
 - Figma, Sketch, or Adobe XD.
- **Contrast Checking**
 - Tools like Stark or manual ratio checks.
- **Focus & Hover States**
 - Show how each interactive element changes on hover or tab focus.
- **ARIA Guidance**
 - Short notes like “Use `aria-label` for close icons,” or “Role=dialog for modals.”

 - Identify any fails and choose new color shades if needed.
2. **Task 2**
 - **Redesign or Update**
 - Provide final versions of each major element with focus outlines, hover states, etc.

3. **Task 3**
 - **Assemble Final Library**
 - A single doc or Figma page with updated components.
 - Indicate recommended code-level changes for focus, e.g., “2px border in brand accent color for focus.”
 - Export or share with the dev team.
